## AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

## RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and CANADA FOAM LTD., Applicant,

- WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Canada Foam Ltd. filed an application with the Department of Mines, Natural Resources and Environment in connection with the operation of a cellulose insulation manufacturing plant located at or near 105 Maple Street North in the City of Winnipeg, Manitoba;
- AND WHEREAS in the absence of limits being prescribed by a Regulation issued under The Clean Environment Act, the said application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits;
- AND WHEREAS representation was made to the Commission by persons who may be affected by an order of the Commission prescribing limits in connection with the said operation;
- AND WHEREAS the Commission held a public hearing on the 9th day of October, 1979, to hear evidence and receive representations in connection with the operation;
- AND WHEREAS the Commission considered the application on the 17th day of April, 1979, the 15th day of October, 1979, and again on the 17th day of December, 1979;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- The Applicant shall not permit the emission of particulate matter from the various processes of the said operation to exceed 0.23 grams per standard cubic meter calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimeters of mercury at the point of emission.
- The Applicant shall not permit the emission of particulate matter from any source of the said operation to exhibit an opacity greater than 5 percent past the property line of the said operation.
