

## AN ORDER OF THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION UNDER THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT ACT

RE: THE CLEAN ENVIRONMENT COMMISSION and MANITOBA POOL ELEVATORS, Applicant,

WHEREAS

pursuant to the provisions of The Clean Environment Act, Manitoba Pool Elevators filed an application with the Department of Consumer and Corporate Affairs and Environment in connection with the operation of an existing grain elevator located on the Canadian Pacific right-of-way in the Village of Cartwright, Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS

in the absence of limits, terms and conditions prescribed by a regulation under the said Act, the application was referred to The Clean Environment Commission for the prescribing of limits, terms and conditions;

AND WHEREAS

after giving notice of the application, the Commission did not receive a representation from any person who is likely to be affected by an order of the Commission in connection with the said operation;

AND WHEREAS

the Commission considered the application on the 25th day of January, 1982;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

- On and after the 1st day of June, 1982, the Applicant shall not permit the emission of particulate matter from any process or point of emission of the said operation in excess of 0.23 grams per standard cubic metre calculated at 25 degrees Celsius and 760 millimetres of mercury at the point of emission.
- 2. On and after the 1st day of June, 1982, the Applicant shall limit the wind entrainment of particulate matter from any source of the said operation to such an extent that the particulate matter does not remain visible past the property line of the said operation.
  - The Applicant shall maintain a high standard of equipment maintenance and good housekeeping practices at all times consistent with meeting the limits prescribed in this order.

4. The Applicant shall establish and carry out a procedure for the inspection and timely emptying of the dust collecting tanks associated with the said operation in such a manner as to ensure the said dust collecting tanks are at all times maintained in effective operating condition until such time as alternative dust collecting facilities are in operation to control emissions from the said operation.
