**RE: Environment Act Licence Suspension
Discharge of Effluent from Elm Creek Wastewater Treatment Lagoon**

This letter acknowledges the request submitted by the Rural Municipality of Grey on July 25, 2017, to commence discharge of effluent from the secondary cell of the Elm Creek Wastewater Treatment Lagoon without meeting the effluent limit for total coliform specified in Environment Act Licence 2420.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 16(c) of Environment Act Licence 2420 pursuant to Section 18(1) of The Environment Act which allows you to proceed with the discharge of the secondary cell of the lagoon. The suspension is in effect from July 28, 2017 to August 10, 2017, inclusive for this event.

Please be advised that if weather conditions become unsuitable, discharge must cease and authorization may be revoked. All other clauses in Environment Act Licence 2420 remain in effect.
