## R3 INNOVATIONS INC. AND TOWN OF NEEPAWA INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY EXPANSION – FILE: 2755.20

A proposal was filed on behalf of R3 Innovations Inc. and the Town of Neepawa for the expansion and operation of the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility (IWWTF) located in the southwest quarter of Section 35, Township 14, Range 15 WPM in the Town of Neepawa. The proposed changes to the development include the construction of an additional aeration tank, an extra blower unit, a third membrane cassette in each existing membrane train and replacement of centrifuge feed pumps. Up to 1200 m³/day of treated wastewater from the IWWTF would be discharged on a continuous basis via the existing effluent outfall pipeline with final discharge to the Whitemud River.
