The Historic Resources Branch has reviewed the location of the proposed alteration to the Town of Neepawa's Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility in the SW ¼ of Section 35 Township 14 Range 15 WPM. Our records indicate that the possibility of potential to impact significant heritage resources is low, and, therefore, at this time, the Historic Resources Branch has no concerns with the project.
