RE: Environment Act Licence 1529 – Licence Clause Suspension Request

This letter acknowledges the email request submitted by the RM of St. Laurent on June 1, 2022, to commence discharge of effluent from the secondary cell of the Oak Point Lagoon prior to the discharge period prescribed by Clause 2 (d) of Environment Act Licence 1529.

I am granting a suspension of Clause 2 (d) of Environment Act Licence 1529 pursuant to Section 18(1) of The Environment Act which allows you to proceed with the discharge of the secondary cell of the lagoon. The suspension is in effect from June 10 until June 15, 2022 inclusive.

Please be advised that if weather conditions become unsuitable, discharge must cease and authorization may be revoked. All other clauses in Environment Act Licence 1529 remain in effect.
