Re: Imperial Oil Limited – Winnipeg Distribution Terminal (East St. Paul) – Environment Act Licence No. 3088 – Notice of Alteration

Receipt of your June 21, 2017 submission is acknowledged as a notice of alteration in accordance with Section 14 of The Environment Act.

The requested changes to the Development as Licensed are for temporary storm water storage in an existing bermed area during the stormwater retention pond rehabilitation project as well as changes to the expanded stormwater retention pond dimensions, slopes and outlet pipe.

The information provided states that the discharge requirements of Environment Act Licence No. 3088 will continue to be met and any impacted sludge or soil will be disposed of at an approved facility.

The potential environmental effect of the requested changes to the Development as Licensed are insignificant and considered to be a minor alteration in accordance with Section 14(2) of The Environment Act. Approval is hereby granted for the proposed changes to the Development as described in the June 21, 2017 submission.
