MI has reviewed the proposal under the *Environment Act* noted above and we have the following comments:

- Water Management, Planning and Standards:

The proposed De Salaberry East Station Project lies within the NE of 35-6-4E1 in the RM of De Salaberry. The proposed station is immediately adjacent to Tourond Creek, a Provincial Waterway under Section 14 of the Water Resources Administration Act.

Section 14(4) of the Water Resources Administration Act states:

*No person shall place any material on, remove any material from, or construct, carry out, reconstruct, establish, or place, any works or structures on, over, or across, a provincial waterway, except as may be authorized in writing by the minister and subject to such terms and conditions as the minister may prescribe.*

Although not included in this assessment, the 230 kV transmission lines crossing Tourond Creek will require a Provincial Waterway Authorization, along with any other work on along, or adjacent to the waterway, in accordance with the Water Resources Administration Act.

- Under the *Highways and Transportation Act* and the *Highway Protection Act*, a permit may be required from MI or the Highway Traffic Board, respectively, for:
  - any new, modified or relocated access connection onto a Provincial Road (PR) or a Provincial Trunk Highway (PTH);
  - any construction within 38.1 m (125 ft) or any plantings within 15.2 m (50 ft) from the edge of right-of-way of any PR; and/or
