

## ATTENTION ANGLERS

Sustainable Development is proposing new conservation measures for both anglers and commercial fishers to protect the Walleye stock in Lake Winnipeg. This stock supports the valuable Walleye fisheries in the Red River and the Winnipeg River below Pine Falls in addition to Lake Winnipeg.

Under Possible Changes on page 2 of the angling guide the Possible Change “Remove the requirement for anglers to retain only 1 walleye over 70cm per year and date the back of their fishing licence on the Red River and Winnipeg River” is withdrawn.

This Possible Change is replaced with: “Lake Winnipeg – Anglers may retain only 1 walleye longer than 70cm per year. Licence holders who catch and retain one of these fish must immediately record the date on the back of their licence”
