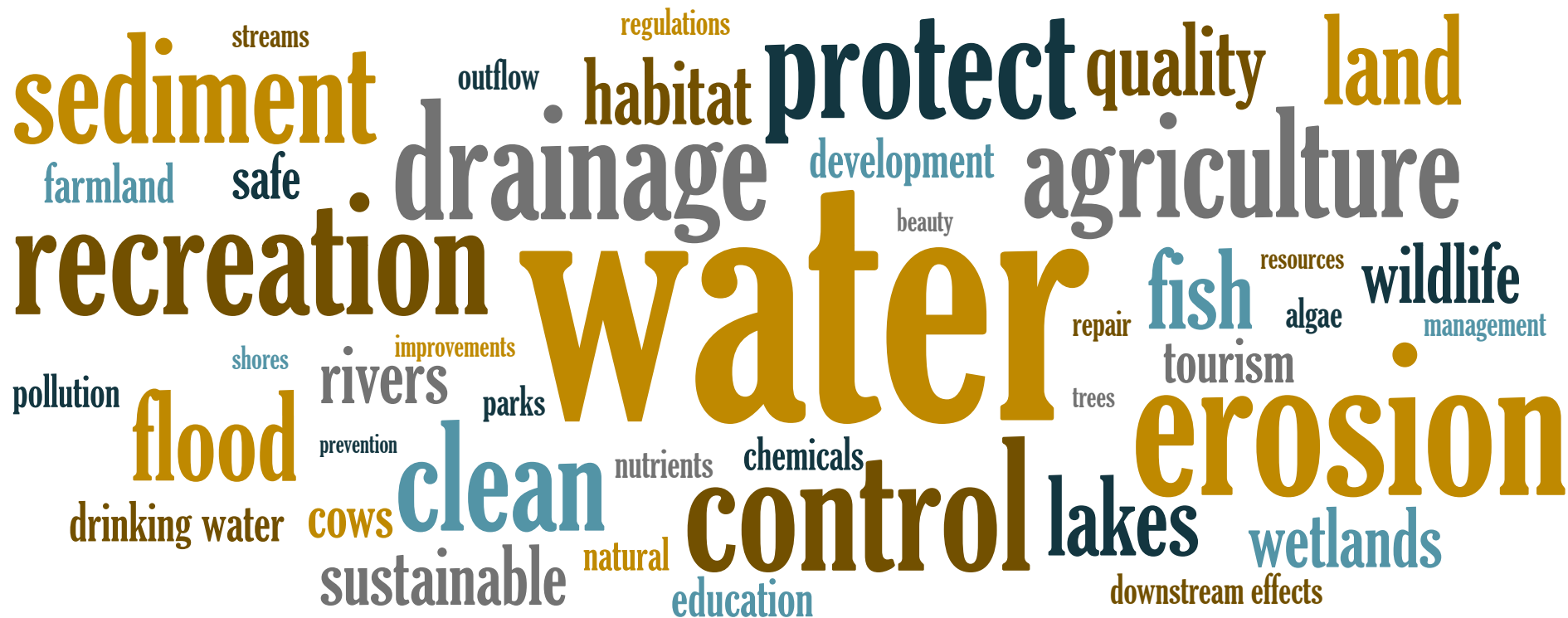
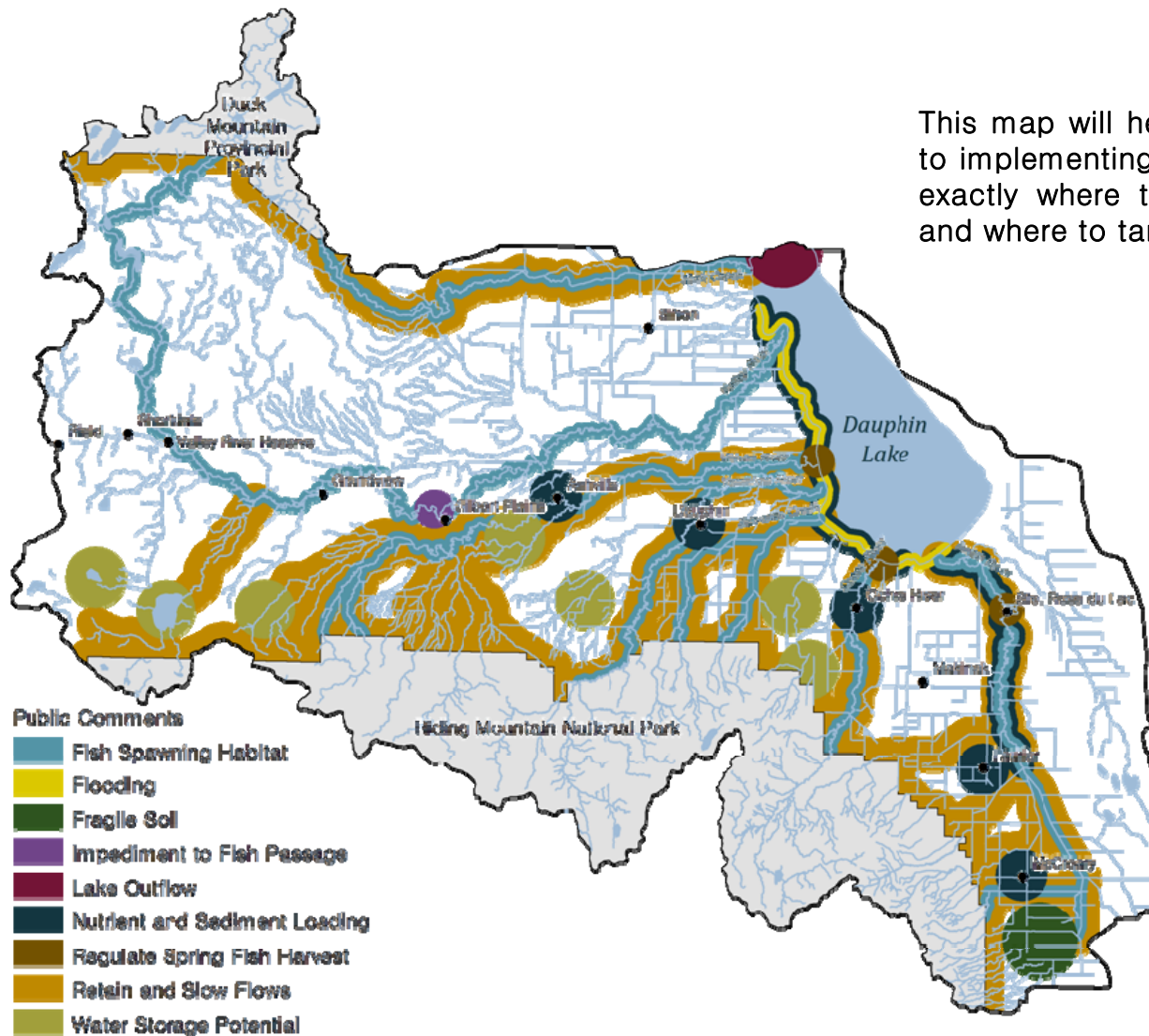


During public meetings held in March 2011, we invited you to share ideas for the Dauphin Lake Integrated Watershed Management Plan.

After the incredible spring we've had, it's no surprise that water, protect, and drainage were frequently discussed. While some residents focused on broad ideas like wide-scale drain maintenance, habitat protection, education, and improving government cooperation, others chose to draw their ideas on a map (below).



This map will help us when it comes to implementing the plan. We'll know exactly where to offer programming and where to target our efforts.

Our locally-led planning team will now work to create a plan that represents these ideas. In the next few months we'll talk with government departments, municipalities, non-profit organizations and you to see how we can put your ideas into action.
