Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of October 21st concerning our recent application for the above Exploratory Gas/Oil Permit.

I note your revised estimate of the area applied for as being 9,500 acres.

Concerning your reference to the small partial grid being applied for from Manitoba, I believe you were earlier informed in our letter of October 7th that this represents only a small portion of a much larger filing undertaken with the Federal Government on the same date of October 7th. I enclose copies of recent correspondence exchanged with the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources on this subject and would particularly draw your attention to paragraph #5 of our Ottawa solicitor's letter.

The small acreage applied for in Manitoba is intended to become an integral part of the Government of Canada permit area also being sought by Piper Mattawa Iron Mines Limited.

It is highly probable that, in our exploration program currently being planned for the permits described, Canada permit #20 will also be included. This permit is presently held by the Aquitaine-Sogepet partnership. You are perhaps aware that I personally direct and control the interests of Sogepet Limited.







If this assumption is correct, then would you consider this letter an application to file on this fractional easterly portion of the subject grid.


