- Reminder: Please ensure you have your employer's consent for technical training dates prior to registering.
- Technical Training payments are non-transferable and non-refundable. Be certain of the COLLEGE, DATE and LEVEL you select before submitting your payment on-line.
- Apprentices who participated in the High School Apprenticeship Program (HSAP) and who have accumulated HSAP incentive credits must call in 204-945-4016/1-888-945-4016 or walk in to register for Technical Training. You will not be refunded if you pay on-line.
- For apprentices who are repeating a level of technical training, you must also call in 204-945-4016/1-888-945-4016 or walk in.
