

Regulation Update

Trade Regulation for Gas Turbine Repair and Overhaul Technician

On May 12, 2017, the Manitoba government amended the trade regulation for the trade of Gas Turbine Repair and Overhaul Technician, Manitoba Regulation 48/2017. The following details the changes that have been made to the regulation and will be effective beginning May 12, 2017.

Term of Apprenticeship

The term of apprenticeship for the trade is now one level, consisting of a period of at least 24 months during which an apprentice must complete a minimum of 3,600 hours of technical training and practical experience. This change will allow for apprentices to complete all of their technical training at the beginning of the program followed by their practical experience.

Commonly Asked Question

How will this change impact apprentices in the trade?

Level one and level two technical training have been combined into a single level. Apprentices will now be required to complete the technical training portion of their apprenticeship program prior to starting their practical experience. The number of total hours that apprentices are required to complete as well as the total calendar time remains unchanged.

Who will be affected by the regulatory change?

All apprentices who register or who are currently registered in the trade are required to complete the new term of apprenticeship.
