# Employer of the Year Award - Internationally Experienced Tradespersons Nomination Form

The Apprenticeship Manitoba Awards of Distinction recognize employers, journeypersons and instructors who have made an outstanding contribution to Manitoba's apprenticeship training system.

Nominations are being accepted for the *Employer of the Year Award – Internationally Experienced Tradespersons* (IET), recognizing an outstanding Manitoba business/organization that has made a significant contribution to support the integration and trade certification of IET through the trades qualification process.

Award recipients will be formally acknowledged during the Awards of Distinction event.

#### Information & Eligibility Criteria

Individuals may nominate an outstanding Manitoba business/organization that has employed an IET who has become trade certified through the trades qualification process within the past two years. An employer for this award is defined as a business or organization that engages individuals to work for them as certified journeypersons and pays wages.

Members serving on the awards selection committee are not eligible to nominate, and if they are an owner, their business/organization will not be considered for nomination. Only one business/organization may be nominated per form. The number of nominations for the same business/organization will not be a factor in the selection process.

#### Award Criteria

The Employer of the Year – IET must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Demonstrate support for trade certification through the Manitoba apprenticeship trades qualification process;
- 2. Encourage success of IET by:
  - a. Providing employment opportunities through recognition and full utilization of their skill sets
  - b. Offering on-the-job training leading to enhanced job-related skills and competencies for workplace participation and full integration;
- 3. Creates a workplace environment that encourages excellence;
- 4. Acts as a leader in their industry;
- 5. Demonstrating a strong interest in, and a commitment to diversity in the workplace, offering opportunities to gain exposure to the Canadian workplace.

#### Nomination Instructions

- Thoroughly answer all questions and provide as much information as possible to clearly demonstrate how the employer meets the award criteria.
- Strengthen your nomination by providing examples, stories, and details of exceptional conduct and/or attributes. If necessary, attach additional information.
- Nominations received after the nomination closing date will not be considered.
