

1. CURRENT STANDING ITEMS

- 1.1 The meeting was called to order at 9:02 A.M.

2. PROGRAM STANDARDS

2.1 Trade Regulation Update

The Cook Industry Working Group (IWG) was informed that the trade regulation is rescheduled for review, as the Canadian Council of Directors (CCDA) has increased the levels within the Cook trade from two levels to three levels. As such, the Cook trade regulation will be reviewed after the IWG amends the current training standards to reflect three levels and consults with industry. Once the committee makes its final technical training standards recommendations to the Program Standards Standing Committee, the IWG will be tasked to review, amend the trade regulation, consult with industry and make final recommendation to the Program Standards Standing Committee and the Apprenticeship and Certification Board.

In addition, the IWG was informed that any new regulatory amendments are required to undergo a 45-day consultation period on the public consultation portal before the proposed regulation comes into effect. This requirement is part of the government-wide Red Tape Reduction Initiative. Once the 45-day consultation period is complete, the regulation will be returned to the Board and the Minister for signature.

2.2 Cook Technical Training

Closed.

The Cook Provincial Advisory Committee is currently un-constituted. The IWG was formed in absence of PAC. The Branch staff informed the IWG that the CCDA has recommended increasing the Cook term of apprenticeship from two levels to three levels. The IWG and the Red River College Instructor were in favour of the CCDA recommendations and reviewed each level thoroughly using the 2018-2019 Cook Red Seal Occupational Standards. The IWG made amendments to the technical training and approved the proposed technical training for an industry-wide consultation.
