

- Improper smoke sealing
- intumescent fire stopping
- Fire, smoke and combination fire/smoke dampers

It was confirmed that each subject that the responder inquired about was already incorporated into the proposed technical training.

The PAC decided to proceed with its proposed technical training as written and submit to the Program Standards Standing Committee for review approval.
