

The Canadian Council of Director of Apprenticeship and the Apprenticeship and Certification Board identified Ironworker trade for technical training review, in light of the harmonization efforts. It was noted that another technical training standards review may take place in 2023.

Due to recruitment challenges, an Industry Working Group (IWG), comprised of PAC members and an industry stakeholder, was formed to review the technical training. As such, the IWG, Red River College Instructor and Branch staff reviewed the Level Chart, and Units of Instruction and made revisions that will be incorporated into the documents.

Review Consultation Process

According to The Apprenticeship & Certification Act, the PACs must consult with industry regarding the changes to the technical training.

Branch staff advised the IWG that the suggested revisions will be incorporated into the draft Consultation Discussion Guide. Once the IWG approves the Consultation Discussion Guide, the document will be circulated to industry. After the consultation period is closed, the PAC will meet to review industry comments and discuss its final recommendations to the Program Standards Standing Committee.

The IWG reached consensus and determined to distribute the consultation to industry stakeholders for feedback on the proposed technical training standards.
