

To encourage improved data collection, Manitoba Agriculture and Resource Development (MARD) will provide an incentive of \$150 to beef cattle and bison producers in the Riding Mountain Eradication Area (RMEA) who link their Premises Identification (PID) locations to their Canadian Cattle Identification Agency (CCIA) account. This linkage will allow animals examined at slaughter to be traced back to the herd level and further demonstrate that livestock shipped from the RMEA are free of bovine tuberculosis (bTB). Improving slaughter surveillance can play a significant role in assuring ongoing disease freedom.

Producers who want to complete this data linkage, or who have already done so, can apply for this one-time payment. If you have more than one CCIA account associated with your livestock operation in the RMEA, please list all of these accounts. If you do not yet have a PID number, complete a PID application and include it with this data incentive application. Send the completed application form to:

NOTICE – WHY WE COLLECT PERSONAL INFORMATION OF PRODUCERS PARTICIPATING IN THE MANITOBA BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS (bTB) DATA INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Manitoba Agriculture and Resource Development (MARD) is responsible for the operation of the data incentive program.

- (1) MARD collects personal information from you and discloses personal information about you to program partners, including the CCIA and MBP, for the following purposes only:
 - to verify eligibility and administer, monitor, evaluate and audit payments;
 - to contact you about other program assistance and extension projects related to the management and mitigation of the risk of and evaluation of bTB;
 - to determine your eligibility and assist in the delivery of other financial incentives that may be available to you from MARD and its program partners for the management and mitigation of the risk of bTB;
 - for the preparation of reports about the program by MARD for use by MARD and disclosure by MARD to program partners, including MBP and CCIA.
- (2) Any other use or disclosure of your personal information must be authorized by you or authorized under privacy legislation.
- (3) Where MARD collects personal information about you, the collection is authorized under subsection 36(1) (a) of The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
