

## COVID-19 SAFETY: BERRY FARM FAQ

#### Can my Upick and/or Pre-Pick fruit farm be open this summer?

- YES, under the current Province of Manitoba Public Health Order you can be open but the operator of the business must implement physical distancing measures to ensure that persons attending the place of business are reasonably able to maintain a separation of at least two metres from other persons who are attending the business and staff.

# My business is included on the list of critical services; do I have to limit the number of people allowed in my store?

- No, the 10 people maximum at a public gathering is intended for public events such as weddings, funerals or worship. However, businesses that are open to the public must implement measures to ensure that people attending are reasonably able to maintain a separation of at least two meters from each other.

• Highly unlikely, CFIA states that there is currently no evidence that food or food packages can be a source or route of transmission of the virus. Therefore it is safe to provide cardboard berry boxes.
