

• Bite – should be able to tell the difference between level, scissors, overshot and	Г

• Neck • Shoulder angulation • Prosternum depth of chest • Width of chest between front legs • Topline • Group • Rear angulation (stifle and hock)	1
Check male for testicles Movement	
• Expression - overall appearance of dog's head with special consideration given to the look in his eye (friendly, wary, etc.) Total
