## Food Manufacturing Sales 2025

The food manufacturing industry is the largest manufacturing industry in Manitoba, accounting for 35 per cent of the province's total manufacturing sales in 2025. Manitoba's food manufacturing sales have shown consistent year-over-year growth, rising from \$6.1 billion in 2020 to a peak of \$9.5 billion in 2025. From 2024 to 2025, total food manufacturing sales increased by \$513.9 million (up 5.7 per cent), reinforcing the sector's upward momentum.

Meat products drove most of the growth, rising \$529.4 million (up 15.9 per cent), mainly due to higher pork exports and prices. Meat products remained the largest contributor at \$3.9 billion in sales, accounting for 41 per cent of total food manufacturing sales.

Grain and oilseed manufacturing, which holds the position as Manitoba's second largest food manufacturing sector, experienced a notable decline in 2025. Sales dropped by \$209.3 million, marking a decrease of 10.1 per cent compared to the previous year. Sales fell from \$2.1 billion in 2024 to \$1.9 billion in 2025, mainly due to lower canola oil and canola meal prices, which partially offset gains in other commodities. In contrast to the decline in grain and oilseed sales, several other food manufacturing categories demonstrated moderate growth, including dairy products, which increased by \$75.1 million (up 7.5 per cent), animal foods, up \$40.1 million (up 7.8 per cent), and other food products, which rose modestly by \$78.6 million (up 3.9 per cent).


In 2025, Canadian food manufacturing sales reached \$154.1 billion, an increase of 3.4 per cent compared to 2024. Manitoba's share of Canadian food manufacturing sales was 6.1 per cent.


**FOOD MANUFACTURING SALES BY COMMODITY IN MANITOBA, 2025**


**TOP FIVE SECTORS CONTRIBUTING TO MANUFACTURING SALES IN MANITOBA, 2025**


## TRENDS IN MANITOBA FOOD MANUFACTURING SALES 2020-2025
