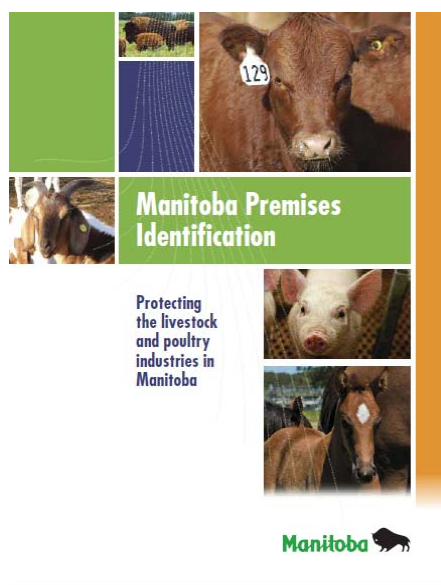
Discover Small Animals - Small Livestock Fact Sheet

Premises Identification



Premises identification is an essential part of a traceability system. In Manitoba, it links livestock and poultry to geographic locations for better management of emergencies. Under the Animal Premises Identification Regulation, all owners and operators of premises with livestock and poultry must complete a premises identification application.
