DECISION YOU ARE APPEALING

Appealable decisions under *The Apprenticeship and Certification Act*

- refusal to issue a certificate of qualification or an occupational certificate
- refusal to permit the person to take an exam in a designated trade or occupation
- refusal to recognize or approve a training or education program
- refusal to permit the person to attempt to qualify for a certificate of qualification without apprenticeship training
- suspension or cancellation of the person's certificate of qualification
- refusal to register an apprenticeship agreement
- refusal to grant a person advanced standing
- suspension or cancellation of the registration of an apprenticeship agreement
- refusal to issue an exemption permit to the person
- refusal to issue a temporary permit to the person
- any other decision specified in the regulations.
