Mandate:

To present, promote, foster and sponsor cultural and artistic activities in the French language for all Manitobans; and manage and develop the buildings and property within the area where the corporation has jurisdiction.

The Centre Culturel Franco-Manitobain Act C45 establishes the board as a governance board. The Act requires the Centre Culturel Franco-Manitobain to provide an Annual Report to the Minister within four months after the end of the fiscal year.

Authority:

The Centre Cultural Franco-Manitobain Act

Responsibilities:

The affairs of the Corporation shall be administered by the Board. Each member is required to sit on a standing committee. Meetings and responsibilities vary with each committee. Standing Committees include: Executive, Finance, Cultural Activities, and Facilities.

Membership:

C.45, Le Centre Culturel Franco-Manitobain Act provides the legislative mandate for the organization. The board is to consist of not more than 8 persons appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council. All board members must be able to participate in the conduct of the board's business in the French language. At least one-half of the members must be appointed from a list of persons nominated by the Société Franco-Manitobain (SFM). The SFM and the CCFM board shall undertake a consultative process to identify persons to be nominated. The Lieutenant Governor in Council must designate one board member as chair and another as vice-chair. Legislation allows an MLA to sit on the Board.

Length of Terms:

Terms are established by the LGC. Custom is that terms are for 3 years or until replacements are named. Members may be reappointed.

Meetings are held monthly except in December and July. Meeting days vary but are generally held at 5:30 pm and last approximately 2 hours. They are held in Winnipeg.
