Mandate:

CancerCare Manitoba is established under *The CancerCare Manitoba Act*. CancerCare Manitoba is charged with the responsibility for cancer prevention, detection, care, research and education for the people of Manitoba.

Responsibilities:

The members of the Corporation set the agenda for the long-term strategies, vision and planning of CancerCare Manitoba, as it relates to diagnosis, treatment, research, public education, undergraduate & postgraduate education, etc. with respect to cancer care/control.

Membership:

The membership of the corporation consists of:

- a) the Minister of Health, Seniors and Active Living;
- b) the chairperson of the advisory medical board appointed under section 6;
- c) one person appointed by the board of the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority;
- d) one person appointed by the board of the St. Boniface General Hospital;
- e) one person appointed by the Board of Governors, University of Manitoba;
- f) ten persons, each from a separate geographical area of Manitoba, appointed by the minister; and
- g) seven persons appointed by the corporation subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

Length of Terms:

Members are appointed to hold office for a term not exceeding three years from the date the appointment becomes effective, and thereafter until a successor is appointed. A member whose term has expired is eligible for reappointment. (A member can serve a term of 3 years – Maximum 2 terms.)

Desirable Expertise:

Some knowledge and interest in health care and/or personal experience with cancer care/control. Previous board experience would be an asset.

Time Commitment:

The board meets monthly (except for July and August).

Meetings:

Board meetings are usually held in the evenings; however, there can be sub-committee work during the day. Meetings are in Winnipeg.

Remuneration:

No remuneration.

Reimbursement for expenses is provided in accordance with CancerCare Manitoba policy.
