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## Reporting COVID-19 and School Vaccine Doses Administered to Clients without a PHIN

To capture COVID-19 and school vaccines (HPV, hepatitis B, Men-C-ACWY-135, Tdap/Tdap-IPV) administered to persons without a Manitoba personal health identification number (PHIN) in the provincial immunization registry (PHIMS), including clients who cannot be found in PHIMS, please complete the updated FILLABLE form, which can be completed online, printed and faxed to 204-957-4342 every Monday and Thursday of each week. The form is available online at:

To minimize data entry errors, please complete the fillable form online (as opposed to printing and completing the form by hand).

As communicated on August 11, 2021 (protectmb.ca/wp-content/uploads/2021/08/Memo-to-HCPs-no-sigs.pdf): please ensure all vaccine doses administered are recorded in PHIMS within two business days of administration to the client/patient, via:

- direct entry into PHIMS for public health; OR
- direct entry into PHIMS for pharmacists for COVID vaccines only; OR
- the Drug Program Information Network (DPIN) for pharmacists for school vaccines; OR
- the Claims Processing System for fee-for-service (FFS) physicians and, non-FFS physicians/nurse practitioners via shadow billing. (The tariff code listing is available at: gov.mb.ca/health/publichealth/surveillance/immunization/docs/mims\_tariff\_codes.pdf).

Do **NOT** use the inputting form (www.gov.mb.ca/health/publichealth/cdc/div/docs/iifhcp.pdf) referred to in the August 11th memo for entering COVID vaccines or school vaccines for clients without a PHIN. Rather, please use the updated FILLABLE form (as linked above) for pharmacies and medical clinics.
