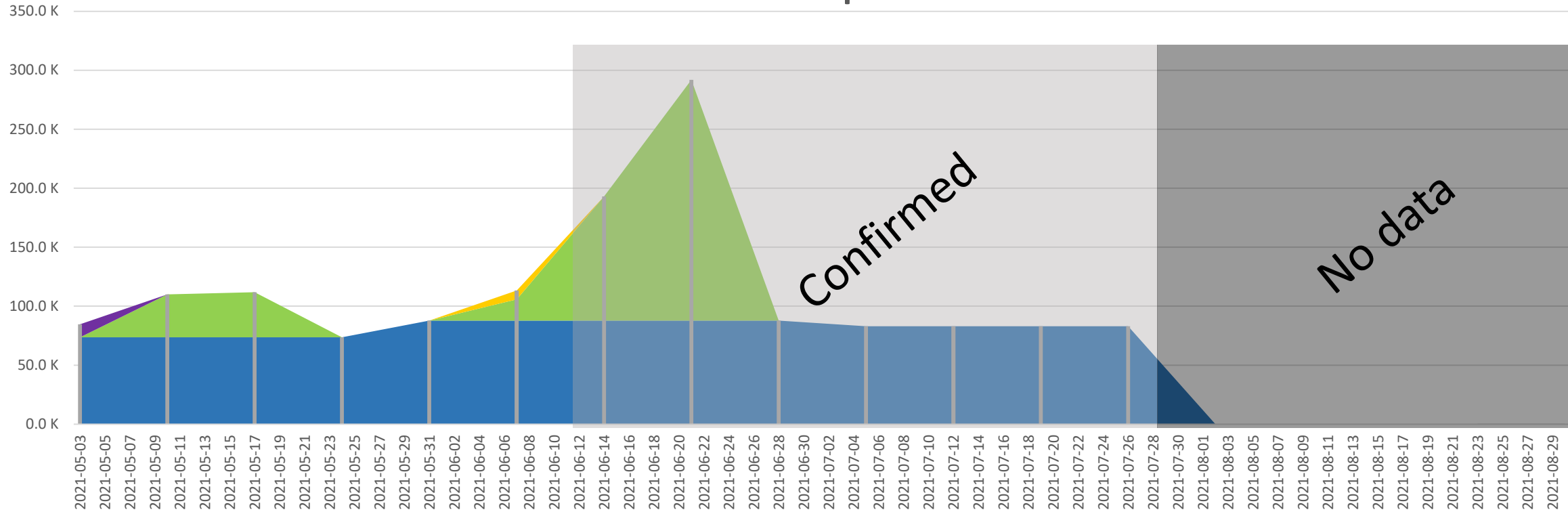

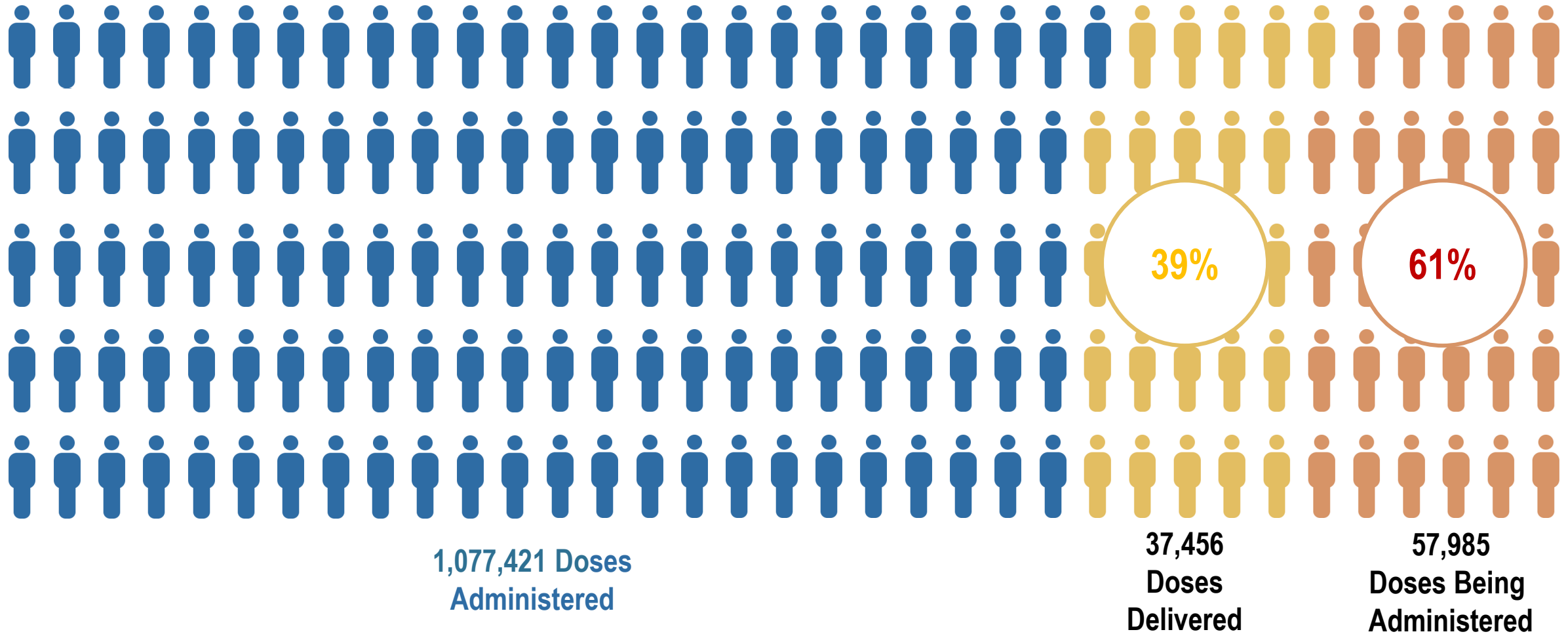

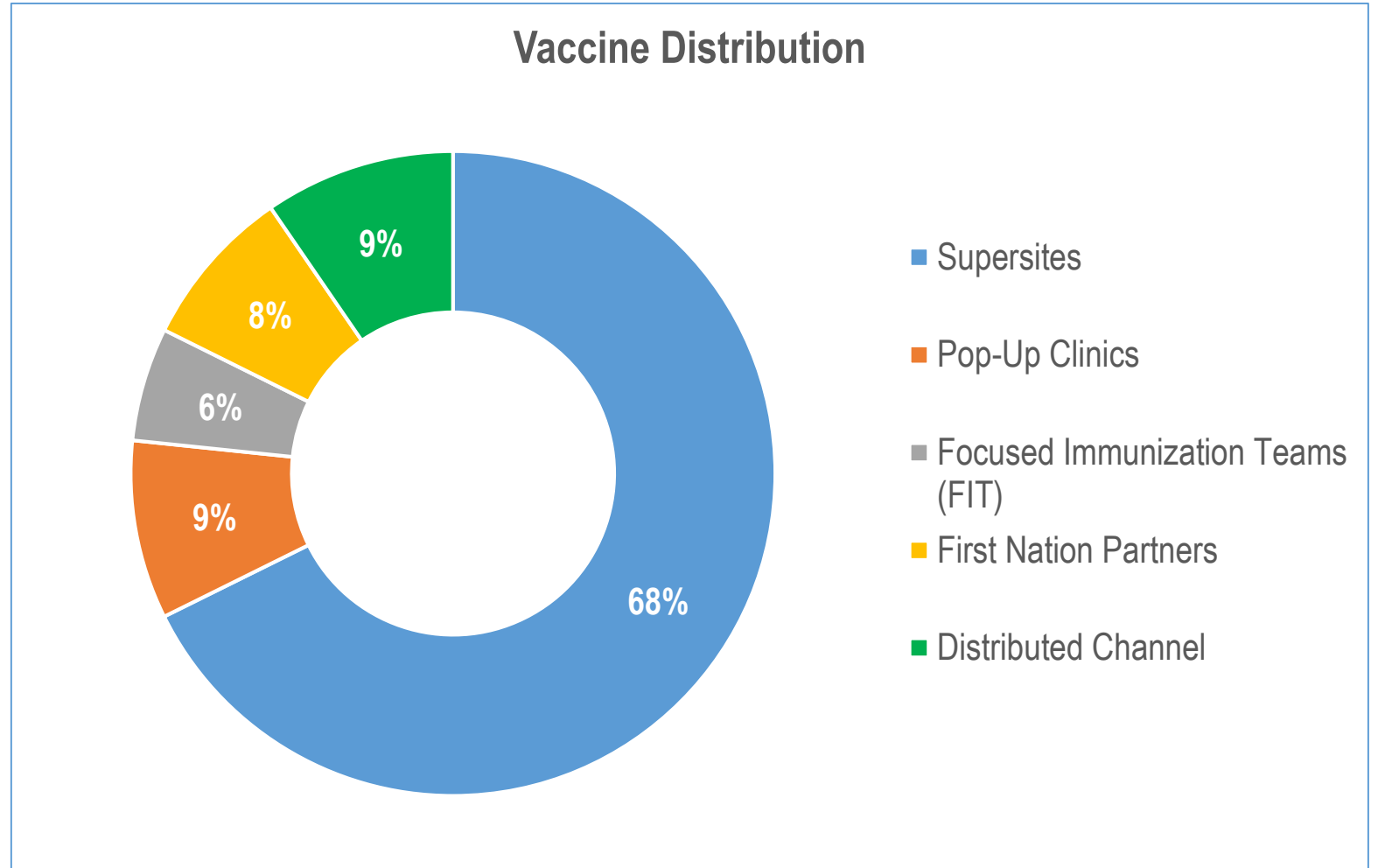

Where Manitoba's Doses Have Gone



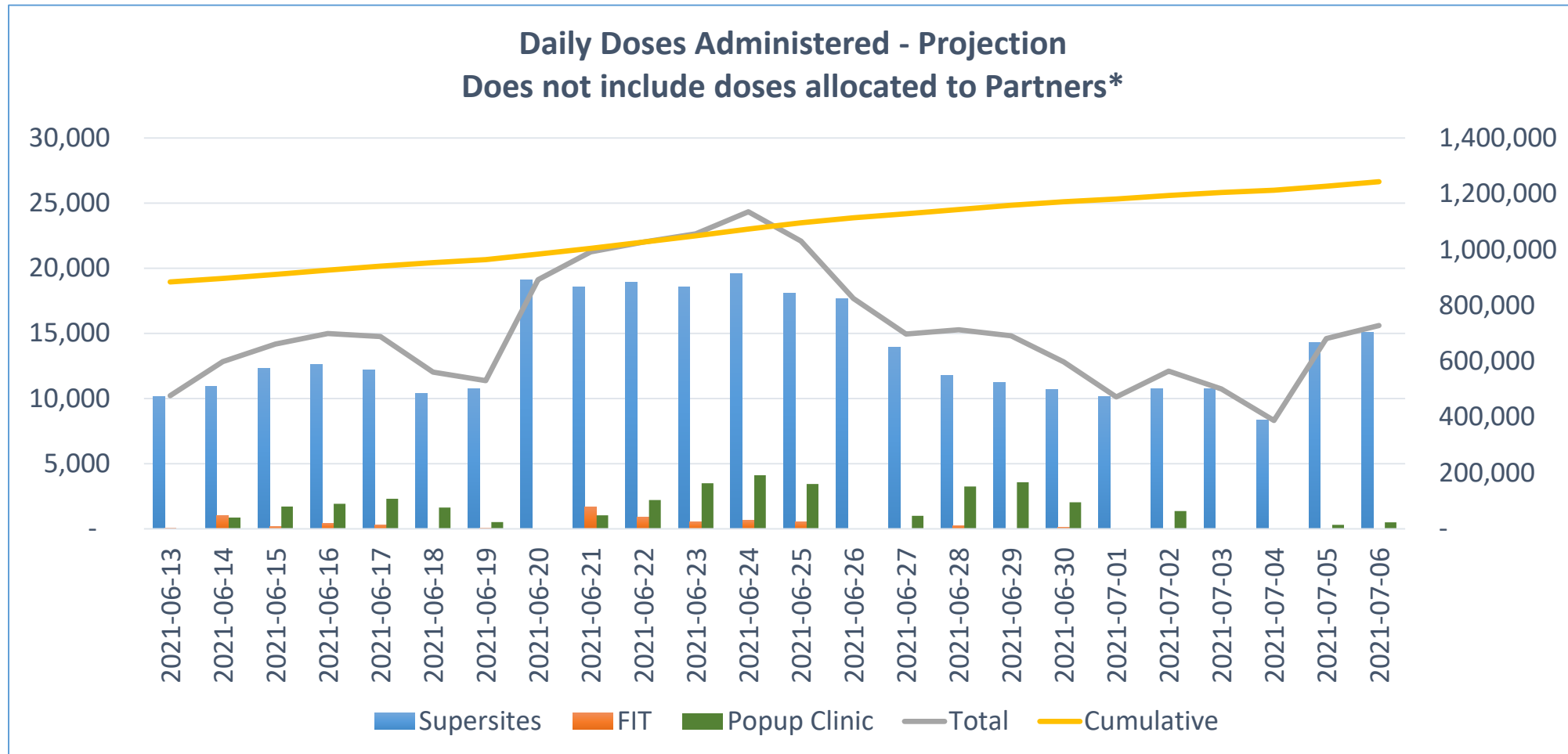

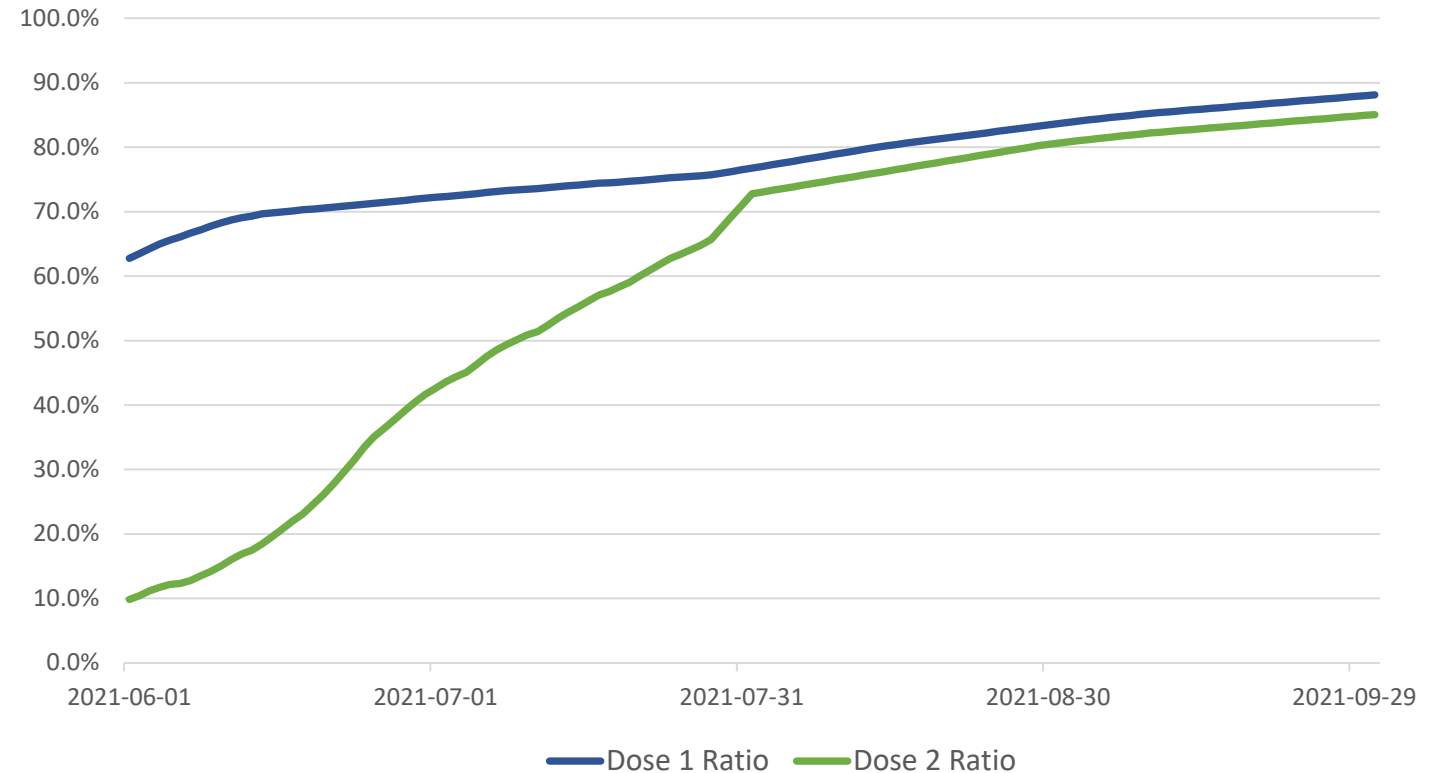

VACCINE DISTRIBUTION



Focus on Vaccine Access & Speed

- 1 million dose milestone
- Applying information from the epidemiology and surveillance team to focus efforts & partnerships in communities with lower immunization rates
- Building capacity: RBC delivered its highest daily doses ever over the weekend:
 - Friday: 7,920
 - Saturday: 8,118
 - Sunday: 7,920
- Planning focuses on how to deliver first and second doses quickly, while also improving access to immunization

Booked Appointments

- Moderna shipment will be used at pop-up clinics and other locations, scheduled throughout June
- Added 40,000+ Winnipeg appointments next week with Moderna shipment
- Continue to expand 2nd dose eligibility, transitioning to expanding Monday to Friday
- Urban Indigenous clinics can receive additional doses if they have capacity to expand

VACCINE ACCESS



Medical Clinics & Pharmacies

- 5x increase in doses allocated to medical clinics and pharmacies (distributed channel model)
- Last week: allocated 6,000 mRNA doses
- This week: allocated 30,000+ mRNA doses
- Next week: 30,000+ to be allocated, depending on next shipments

VACCINE ACCESS



Community Clinics, Mobile Clinics and IIP

- Community-based clinics:
 - 17 planned,
 - almost 3,000 doses allocated
 - Businesses, non-profits, community organizations
- Mobile clinics:
 - Allocating doses for unsheltered, vulnerable or other hard to reach populations
 - 180 doses per week
 - Includes clinical team and outreach workers
- Independent Immunization Partners:
 - shifting from focused immunization teams to self-directed vaccine campaigns.
 - hospitals, personal care homes, correctional facilities, etc

Walk-in Appointments

- 3,000 walk-in appointments at Leila June 15-17
- Walk-ins at several locations this week with True North Sports + Entertainment
- Plan to add 10% capacity for Moderna walk-ins (1st or 2nd dose) at all supersites, except RBC, beginning:
 - June 20: Leila, Brandon, Dauphin, Morden
 - June 22: Selkirk, Gimli
 - June 24: Steinbach

- Walk-ins already allowed in Thompson and The Pas
