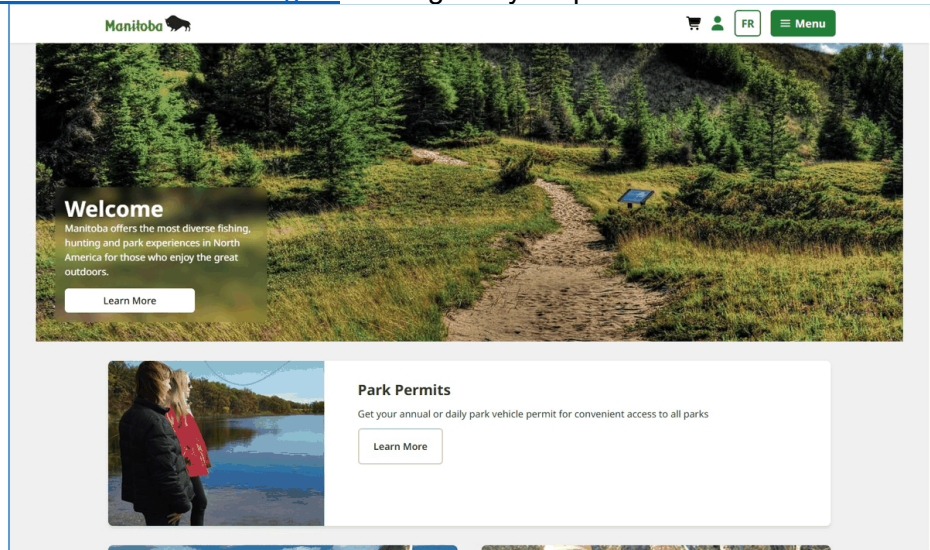
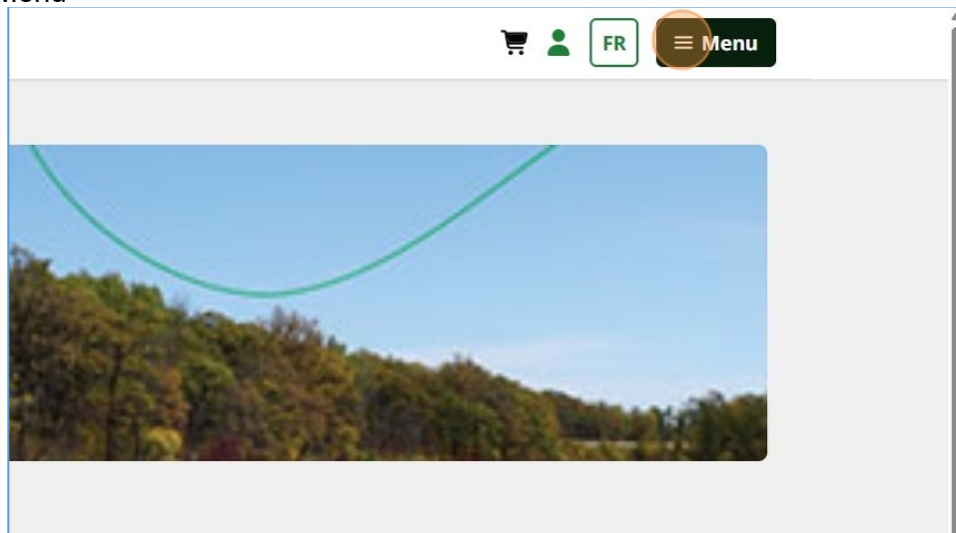


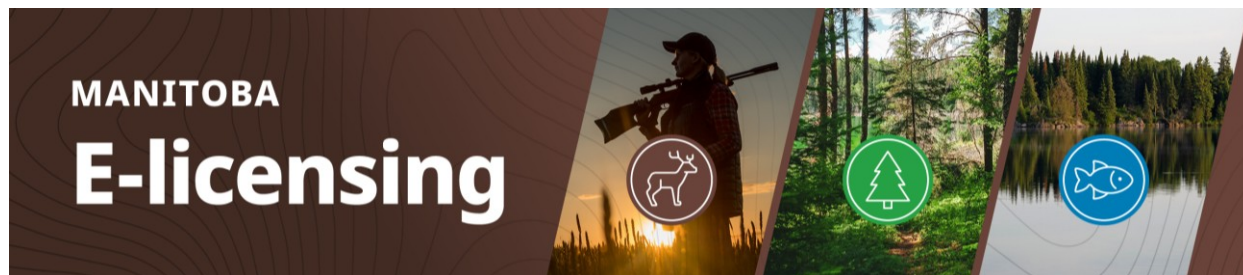
How to purchase a Park Vehicle Permit

1. Go to www.manitobaelicensing.ca and login to your profile.



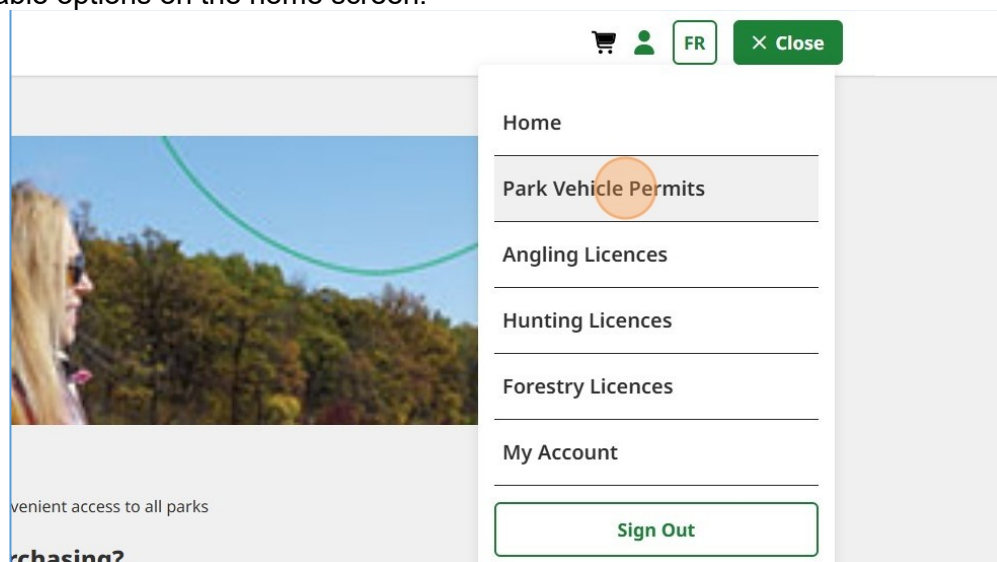
2. Click "Menu"





How to purchase a Park Vehicle Permit

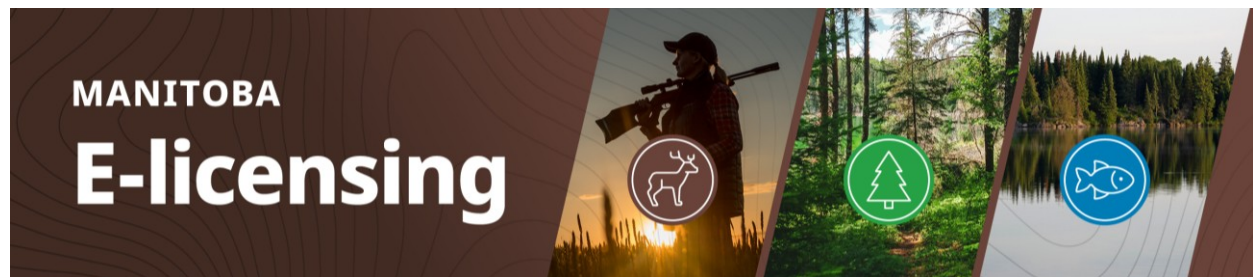
3. Click "Park Vehicle Permits" Alternatively, you may also select Park Vehicle Permit from the available options on the home screen.



4. Select the Park Vehicle Permit you require.

Note: Annual Park or Bus Permits allow you to enter up to two licence plates for two separate vehicles. This option is not available for Casual or Daily permits.

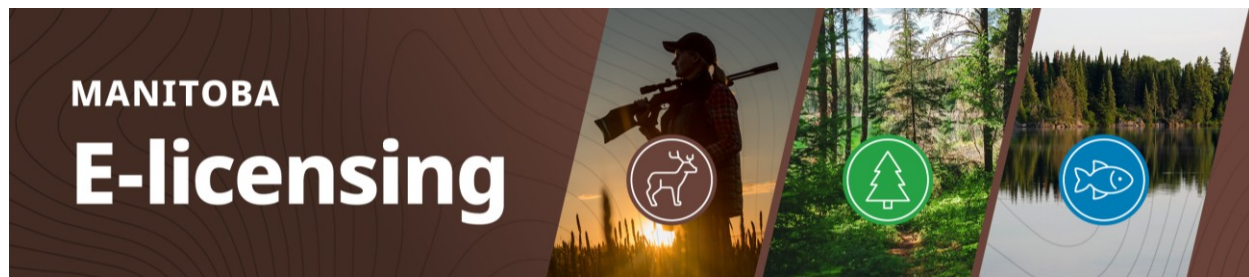

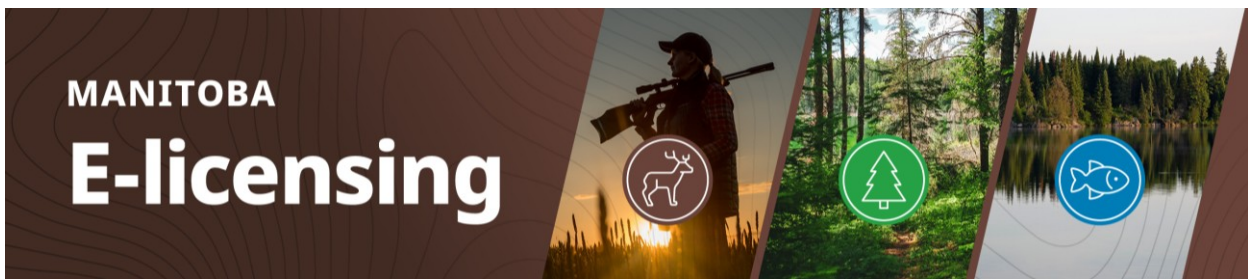

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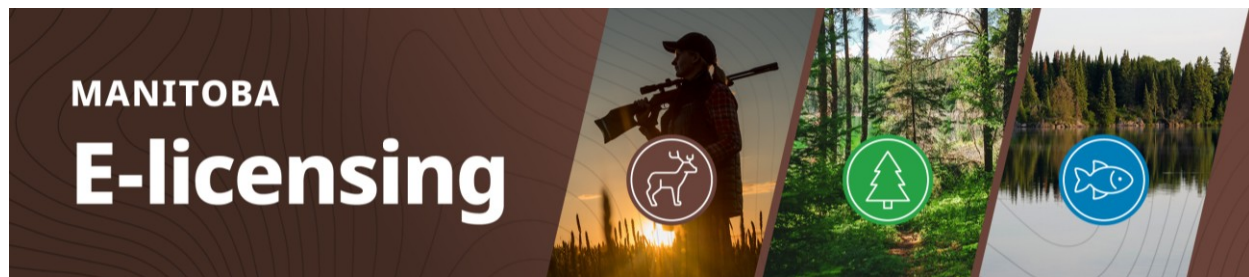

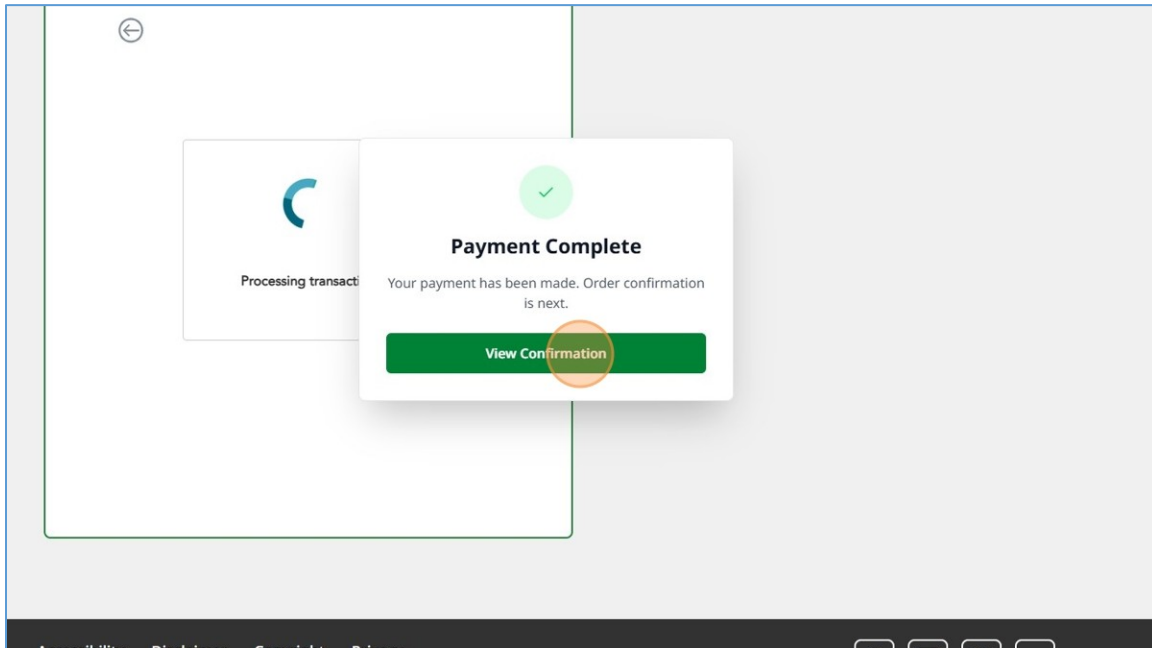
12. Click the "Pay" Button.

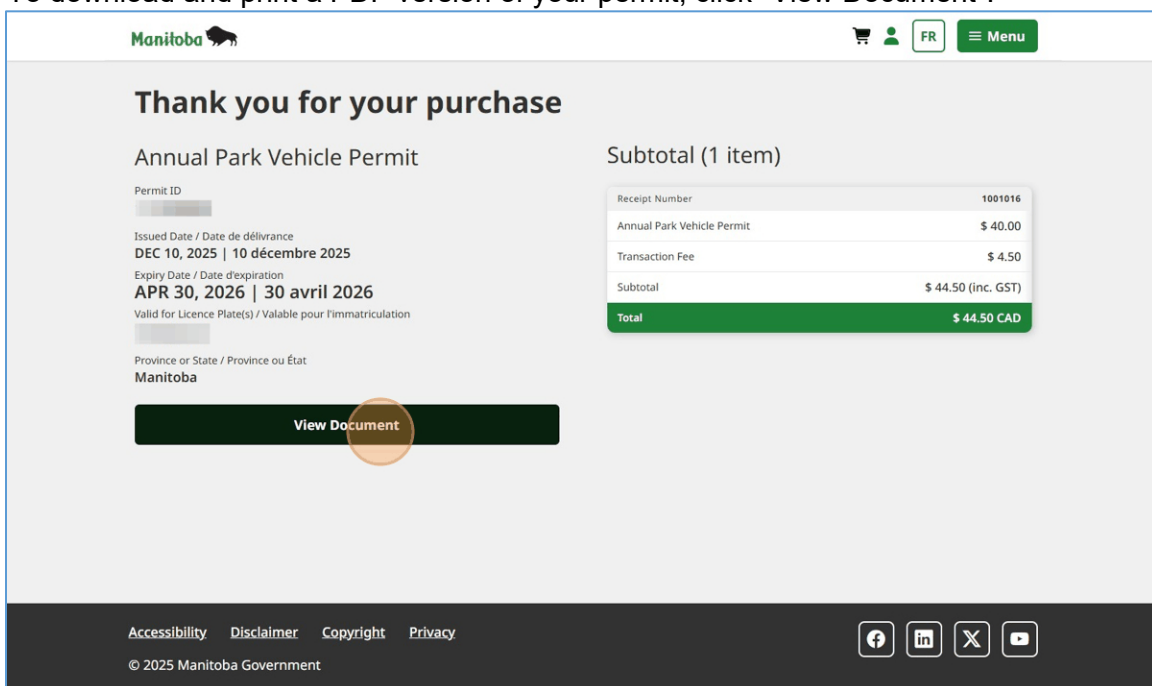

15. The downloaded permit will open in the default program on your computer. You may now print this permit on your connected printer.

Note: The printed permit must be displayed prominently in your vehicle window any time you visit one of Manitoba's Provincial Parks.
