Instructions for Elevator Mechanic Licence:

***Statutory Declaration:** Refers to *ITS ED Form 29 - Statutory Declaration*, this form is completed by a notary or commissioner of oaths. On the declaration the employer must declare the required 9000hrs have been completed working on elevating devices within the Scope of *ASME A17.1 / CSA B44 – Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators*.

****Equivalent Educational Certificates:**

ITS will accept:

- Elevating Device Mechanic Educational Programs recognized by other provinces, or
- other training programs evaluated to meet the similar requirements to CEIEP.

Fees:

The fee for new application is \$160 and is renewed every 4 years. Pro-rated rate is \$40/year.

Applicants that are transferring their credentials from M-A Licence to the new licences do not have to pay an application fee, unless they are overdue.

Journeyman electricians wishing to obtain an Elevator Mechanic Licence will have to pay an application fee to have both licences.

All information is subject to verification process. ITS Staff may contact employers, mechanics supervising the trainees, and other provincial bodies to verify. False and misleading information may result in cancellation of this application and or administrative penalties in accordance with the Technical Safety Regulation. You may apply for a notice of appeal of these decisions to the director of ITS within 14 business days of notice.
