- a new, stand-alone ministry ensuring greater linkages and alignment between the offerings of Manitoba's advanced education institutions and the skills needed to equip the labour force of the future;
- delivers student aid and financial assistance programs and bursaries that reward and incent more educational opportunities for young Manitobans;
- undertakes a leadership role in developing and delivering quality, relevant skills programming that increases the participation of all Manitobans in the economy through greater adult learning and literacy; and
- attracts and welcomes more immigrants to Manitoba through the province's renowned Provincial Nominee Program and connection with community partners.
