Ann Ulusoy has served as the provincial comptroller-general for Manitoba since 2020. Prior to joining Manitoba’s public service, Ulusoy was the director of management services, parks, forestry and recreation for the City of Toronto where she served as the financial and administrative lead for her department. She also served as senior financial control officer for the U.S. Division of Manulife Finance from 1991 to 1998, vice-president of finance and corporate planning for the MEARIE Group from 1998 to 2004, and a director and business advisor with the Centre for Mental Health and Addiction from 2004 to 2006.

Ulusoy holds a bachelor of commerce, a diploma in public administration, and designations as a certified professional accountant and a certified management accountant.
