

Case Rate


Manitoba's rate of reported cases is declining.

The rate of cases (over the last 7 days) was 229 per 100,000 population, as of February 10.




Case Rate

Wastewater Surveillance



Wastewater surveillance indicates transmission dropping



Low confidence: SARS-CoV-2 was detected in only one of two replicates.
High confidence: SARS-CoV-2 was detected in both replicates; presented as the average viral load.
Orange line represents the limit of quantification of the assay.

Hospitalizations


New hospitalizations decreased by 23.7% (334 to 255) from last week




ICU Admissions

All Covid-19 - ICU Admissions by Age group starting ICU Admission week 30 (2021)




All Covid-19 ICU Admission rates by Age group starting ICU Admission week 50 (2021)




Deaths



Manitoba is on a decreasing trajectory for hospital admissions and has likely reached peak hospital occupancy.


