Ministerial Order pursuant to clause 12(1)(b) of *The Emergency Measures Act*, CCSM c E80

The Province of Manitoba is experiencing widespread and severe wildfires and very high to extreme fire danger across the province that requires prompt action to prevent or limit loss of life, harm or damage to the safety, health or welfare of people and damage to property and the environment.

Pursuant to subsection 10(1) of *The Emergency Measures Act* (Act), a State of Emergency in the whole of the Province of Manitoba was declared on May 28, 2025. Evacuation orders have been issued for a number of communities in Manitoba due to the serious and widespread risks of wildfires.


In response to the State of Emergency, I, the minister responsible for the administration of the Act, hereby order the City of Winnipeg, and any lessees or tenants of all or part of the premises in this Order, pursuant to clause 12(1)(b) of the Act, to take the following measures to prevent, combat or alleviate the effects of the emergency or disaster:

1. The City of Winnipeg, and any lessees or tenants of all or part of the premises, shall provide the indoor facilities and associated parking spaces located at 1377 Clarence Avenue (Century Arena), 709 Keewatin Street (Billy Mosienko Arena) and 535 Oakdale Drive (Eric Coy Arena), all in Winnipeg, for the purpose of congregate living accommodations or related support services for evacuees from communities that are the subject of active evacuation orders.

This Order shall remain in effect until the termination or expiry of the State of Emergency, unless sooner revoked.
