## Revocation of Ministerial Order EMO 2025-02 made pursuant to clause 12(1)(b) of *The Emergency Measures Act*, CCSM c E80

Pursuant to subsection 10(1) of *The Emergency Measures Act* (Act), a State of Emergency in the whole of the Province of Manitoba was declared on May 28, 2025. Evacuation orders have been issued for a number of communities in Manitoba due to the serious and widespread risks of wildfires.

In response to the State of Emergency, on June 6, 2025, I, the minister responsible for the administration of the Act, issued Ministerial Order EMO 2025-02, which ordered the City of Winnipeg, and any lessees or tenants of all or part of the premises identified in the Order, to take measures to prevent, combat or alleviate the effects of the emergency or disaster pursuant to clause 12(1)(b) of the Act.

The measures in Ministerial Order EMO 2025-02 are no longer necessary to prevent, combat or alleviate the effects of the emergency or disaster.

Therefore, Ministerial Order EMO 2025-02 is revoked, effective immediately.
