The Directory may also be useful to Indigenous business and general business when seeking partnerships or sub-contractor arrangements.

An Indigenous business may also be asked at the time it submits a bid to certify that it continues to qualify as an Indigenous business. Indigenous businesses should inform Procurement and Supply Chain of any changes in their profile such as ownership, location, contacts and changes in goods and services.
