- “Thomas Flewin & wife” appear on a list of passengers aboard the barque *Norman Morison*, which left the East India Import Dock, London, on 15 August 1852, and “stood in for Esquimalt Harbour [Vancouver Island]” on 16 January 1853 (C.1/615 fo. 2)
