1912 Built at Athabasca Landing for service on Athabasca River
1914 With arrival of railway at Mirror Landing decided to send vessel to Peace River via Grand Rapids & Vermillion Chutes
1915-1917 In service on Peace River
1917 At end of season hauled out at Peace River Crossing; decided not to place in commission for 1918; contract made with Peace River Development Corporation to handle supplies
