".... Since I last wrote you, the Brigade has been to this place, and in going up, one of the Boats, I am sorry to say, was swamped in a whirlpool [at the Dalles of the Columbia], most of the property in her lost, and one of the men, named [Leon] Arcouet, drowned --- and another, Swanson, his setting pole slipped, he fell out of the boat into the water, and never appeared again".
