He is probably the John McDonald who married Sarah, the daughter of James Swain, Sr., in 1825. His age is right and the suggestion that he owed his promotion to favouritism would accord with his being Swain's son-in-law. The name of James Swain, Sr. appears in one of McDonald's ledger accounts.

From the card index to the Anglican Parish Registers, Provincial Archives of Manitoba:

12 July 1825 John McDonald married Sarah, daughter of James Swain "supposed residence, England and a native woman." Sarah was baptized the same day, as were their two daughters, Catherine & Flora

- 25 Sept. 1827 Baptism of their daughter Mary
- 22 Sept. 1829 Baptism of their daughter Charlotte
- 15 Nov. 1831 Baptism of their son Donald
- 4 May 1834 Baptism of their son John

From the card index to the 1870 Red River Census, Provincial Archives of Manitoba:

John McDonald is listed as a widower of 81 years, born in Scotland, the son of Angus McDonald. Children listed with him are: James, aged 26, Catherine, aged 50, Christie, aged 28.
