Important Information

Substitutional Service is approved only where

- (a) the applicant has made reasonable attempts to locate and serve the other party; and
- (b) there is a reasonable probability that substitutional service will result in actual notice to the party being served.

Examples of methods of substitutional service:

- 1. Posting the document on the door or placing it under the door of the condominium corporation's place of business;
- 2. Leaving the document with someone who is known to be in regular contact with the condominium corporation to be served; and/or
- 3. Placing an advertisement in a newspaper in the area where the condominium corporation carries on business.

If a hearing was previously scheduled on this matter and the Branch approves this Application for Substitutional Service, it will:

- issue a written approval to the applicant; and
- set a new hearing date, if necessary.
