

AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT MECHANIC

GENERAL

This is journeyman level work in the maintenance and repair of government-owned automotive equipment. Employees of this class generally work in repair centres. They work with a fair degree of independence, but the completed work must conform to accepted trade practices. Work may be checked by a superior while in progress or upon completion. Assignments are received orally or by work order.

TYPICAL DUTIES

Performs all phases of mechanical maintenance, repair and overhaul work on all types of automotive equipment.

Diagnoses motor trouble or mechanical defects and assists in determining the amount of repair work required to put the unit in good running order.

Performs certain work in welding, light forging, machining, painting and body repair work.

Operates various types of equipment utilized in the diagnosing or repairing of the automotive equipment.

Performs related duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills

Considerable knowledge of the standard methods, practices, tools and equipment of the automotive mechanic trade.

Knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions applicable.

Ability to work from oral instructions or work orders with little or no immediate supervision.

Education, Training and Experience

Grade XI education with certification as a journeyman mechanic; some experience in automotive repair.

Physical Standards

Physically capable of performing the duties assigned.
