Subject: Fast Pass rapid testing program

⊠ Procedure

Effective Date: Immediately

Fast Pass rapid testing sites offer a dedicated testing stream for individuals working directly with children in licensed child care and schools. The sites are a tool to slow the spread of COVID-19 through fast identification. In most cases, Fast Pass clients will be able to access their test result on the same day of receiving a test.

There are three Fast Pass locations in Manitoba: 1175 18th Street, Brandon; 1066 Nairn Avenue, Winnipeg; and 485 George Avenue, Winkler.

In order to access testing at a Fast Pass site, individuals must:

- work in a licensed child care centre, nursery school or family/group child care home located in Manitoba, as well as Child Development Specialists/Workers and Autism Applied Behavior Analysis Tutors/Consultants.
- be symptomatic and/or have tested positive on a rapid antigen test.
- show identification and proof of eligibility at the time of appointment
 - the ELCC Program has provided a proof of employer letter template for eligible centre-based facilities and a form on government letterhead for eligible family/group child care homes to complete as proof of eligibility.
 - the Children's disABILITY Services program has provided a proof of employer letter template for eligible child development or Autism staff to complete as proof of eligibility.
