ABOUT THE CHILD CARE SUSTAINABILITY TRUST

The purpose of Childcare Sustainability Trust is to support eligible licensed child care facilities by providing additional grant funding to a variety of projects including infrastructure improvements, innovative program enhancement, equipment, and professional development and learning opportunities for staff, with the goal of developing and enhancing inclusive and accessible services.

- Infrastructure improvement: Major repairs related to maintenance for aging buildings, onetime exceptional support for unexpected events, new or replacement indoor and outdoor equipment to improve play-based learning opportunities
- Program Enhancement: Improved quality, accessibility, and demonstrates inclusivity child
 care programming through new and innovative approaches (e.g. pilot projects that expand or
 shift hours to meet the needs of modern workforce, enhanced services, such as parent
 supports for low-income families or physical space improvements for accessible indoor or
 outdoor spaces)
- Equipment: New equipment, maintenance or replacement of aging equipment
- Professional Development and Learning Opportunities: Initiatives or projects supporting
 ongoing skill development of staff to enhance programming in an innovative way (e.g. culturally
 based training, specialized training for children with additional needs, equipment to support
 virtual learning, purchase of early leaning and development training programs/modules)

Eligibility

To be eligible for one-time Childcare Sustainability Trust funding, child care facilities must be, licensed and operational. Eligible child care facilities may only submit one application, but may apply for more than one project. The funding will provide up to a maximum of \$25,000 for child care centres and \$10,000 for child care homes.

Facilities must submit a completed application form, provide clear description of the project, and include itemized breakdown of costs and/or quotations from at least three registered vendors. Additional information may be requested by ELCC to assist in processing applications.

It is anticipated that more applications may be received than can be accommodated by available funds. All applications will be reviewed and prioritized based on eligible projects meeting the purpose of Childcare Sustainability Trust and assessed level of need. First consideration will be given to underserved Manitoba communities: Indigenous, lone-parent, low-income, Francophone, rural/Northern, low-coverage, newcomer families.
