



Expression of Interest: ECE II Assessment Program Advisors

Are you interested in mentorship and skills development as an Early Childhood Educator?

The Early Childhood Educator (ECE) II Assessment Program is offered through Manitoba Early Learning and Child Care as a pathway to ECE II classification. Eligible Child Care Assistants have an opportunity to upgrade their classification through the demonstration of skills, knowledge, and abilities in all 13 competency areas required of qualified ECE IIs, with support and guidance provided by the Advisor.

The Advisor's Role

- assessing skills, knowledge, and judgment
- observing participants as they work with children
- providing support and feedback on assignments and through the portfolio development process
- identifying and making recommendations to address gaps in skills/knowledge
- providing formal recommendations for ECE certification

Qualifications

Required

- an ECE III classification
- extensive experience in an early learning and child care leadership or management
- an understanding of Prior Learning Assessment processes or adult education
- knowledge of current research in child development, early learning and child care practices, curriculum planning, and adult learning

Desired

- previous experience as an instructor, mentor, manager, or guide
- certificate in Adult Education or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)
- ability to read, write, and verbally communicate fluently in French
