Eligible Costs

Eligible costs generally include incremental expenditures incurred as a direct result of a disaster:

- Response
- Recovery

Eligible Costs -Response

- Evacuations
- Sandbagging
- Construction of dikes
- Equipment rental
- Municipal equipment use
- Establishing emergency operation centers

Eligible Costs - Response

- Registration and inquiry.
- Special security measures.
- Emergency health arrangements.
- Temporary personnel.

Eligible Costs - Recovery

- Debris cleanup
- Infrastructure damage
 - Roads
 - Bridges
 - Uninsurable buildings and structures

Eligible Costs

- Overtime for regular staff
- Backfilling of regular positions assigned to the disaster
- Temporary employees hired for disaster related work
- Engineers and technical reports as requested and pre-authorized by EMO.

Eligible Costs

Eligible costs are generally:

Almost all reasonable and incremental costs incurred from responding to and recovering from a disaster.

Ineligible Costs

- Insurable losses.
- Losses recoverable through other programs.
- Losses recoverable at law.
- Upgrades and improvements.
- Equipment purchase.
- Normal operating costs.
- Standby time.
- Banked overtime.
- Costs not related to the disaster.

Eligible Costs

Must be:

- Event related.
- Supported by a detailed damage report.
- Supported with documentation of incurred costs.
