

Manitoba IFTA Newsletter—4th Quarter 2022

Grace Period

You have a two-month grace period (January and February 2023) to begin displaying your renewed credentials, **if the current renewal was received in our office by December 31, 2022**. However, you must continue to display your 2022 IFTA credentials during this grace period until 2023 credentials are displayed on your vehicles.

Please note that if your renewal is not received in our office by December 31, 2022, you are not eligible for the grace period. This means you will not be able to travel on your 2022 credentials in January and February 2023.

4th Quarter 2022 Tax Return Due Date: Tuesday, January 31, 2023

To avoid penalties and interest, returns must be filed and any amount due must be paid by the above date.

2023 Renewals

If you have not received your 2023 licence and decals, please contact Manitoba Finance.

Please note that IFTA credentials will not be renewed if there is/are:

- Delinquent tax return(s) under IFTA,
- Tax(es) owing under IFTA,
- Delinquent tax return(s) and/or tax(es) owing under other tax statutes administered by Manitoba Finance.

If you do not renew by February 28, 2023, your IFTA account will automatically be closed.

Online Filing of IFTA Quarterly Tax Returns and Payments of Taxes Due

All IFTA quarterly tax returns <u>must</u> be filed and paid online using **TAXcess**, Manitoba Finance's online system. Paper returns are no longer accepted. Taxpayers who fail to file and pay using **TAXcess** when required may be subject to penalties.

IFTA quarterly tax returns for periods prior to 2021 may be filed and paid online but it is not a requirement.

Sign up on the **TAXcess** home page at https://taxcess.gov.mb.ca/.

FILE – When you enter the jurisdictions you travelled in, the fuel type used, total and taxable kilometres travelled and tax paid fuel purchased, the tax due or credit is calculated for you. You no longer have to enter tax rates or manually calculate fuel consumption.

PAY – You can pay any tax owing by electronic, pre-authorized payment (PAD). This allows you to file and pay IFTA through the **TAXcess** website in one continuous process.

VIEW – You can view your IFTA account online, such as your IFTA Statement of Account, IFTA licences and summary of returns filed. You can also view all Web Notices (e-mails) sent and received.

Winnipeg and Brandon Office Hours

In person service at our Brandon office at 314, 340 9th Street is also available on Tuesdays, from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Brandon office staff can issue IFTA licences and decals during this time.

IFTA carriers who need decals immediately and cannot attend one of our offices can contact our Winnipeg office at 204-945-6444. A Temporary Decal Permit can be e-mailed or faxed to you once approved. As the permit is only valid for 30 days, you must purchase decals by completing the "Application for Additional IFTA Decals" here and send the form and payment to the Winnipeg office. The Temporary Decal Permit must be carried in the vehicle named on the permit, along with a paper or electronic copy of your Manitoba IFTA licence

While face coverings are no longer mandatory for all individuals attending the Manitoba Finance offices, individuals may continue to choose to wear masks based on their preference, personal risk or other reasons.

As well, please practice physical distancing, keeping a distance of at least 2 arms lengths (approximately 2 metres) from others as much as possible.



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Fuel Tax Holidays

Due to rising fuel costs, some IFTA jurisdictions are allowing the purchase of eligible fuel tax exempt or pausing the collection of fuel taxes for a specified time period.

Newfoundland and Labrador (NL) initially implemented their fuel tax holidays as a split tax rate in 2nd quarter 2022 (now a reduction in the tax rate for 3rd and 4th quarters 2022). Connecticut (CT), Georgia (GA) and New York (NY) have suspended the collection of fuel taxes. The fuel tax holiday for each jurisdiction is listed below:

NL - June 2, 2022 to December 31, 2022

CT- April 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022 (gasoline and gasohol only)

GA - March 18, 2022 to January 10, 2023

NY - June 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022

Connecticut Highway Use Fee

As of January 1, 2023, a Highway Use Fee will be imposed on certain carriers for the privilege of operating certain heavy, multi-unit motor vehicles on any highway (i.e., public road) in Connecticut. The Highway Use Fee is calculated based on a vehicle's weight and number of miles driven in the state. The Highway Use Fee is applicable to calendar months beginning on or after January 1, 2023. The first Highway Use Fee Return is due on or before February 28, 2023. Certain carriers will be required to register with DRS for the Highway Use Fee by January 1, 2023.

Our goal is to respond to your IFTA credentials requests in a timely manner. Once the completed application form with payment (if applicable) is received and approved, we will process your request and forward to you as required by mail, fax or e-mail within the following response times:

Initial IFTA Registration – seven (7) to ten (10) business days Renewal of IFTA Credentials – fifteen (15) business days Additional Decals – one (1) business day Temporary Decal Permit – one (1) business day

For urgent requests, contact us at 204-945-6444. Response times may vary if **any** tax accounts are not in good standing.
