Paying IFTA through TAXcess or your financial institution? A copy of the return and worksheet must be sent to our office via email, fax or mail. See our contact information below.

Note:

Faxed or emailed returns are accepted if the return is NIL, has a credit balance or paid on **TAXcess** or through your financial institution bill payments. <u>These are accepted as an original tax return</u>. Do not send us a duplicate return.

Returns that are not received will be considered late filed and penalty and interest will be assessed.

***Please note that licence and decal fees cannot be paid through TAXcess. ***
