2019 Renewals

The 2019 licence and decal fee will remain at \$65 per carrier and \$5 per set, respectively.

Renewal forms will be mailed in the first week of November. Please complete the form and return with payment to our office. Please note that licence and decal fees **cannot** be paid through **TAXcess**.

The 2019 IFTA credentials will **not** be renewed if the third quarter has not been filed or there are delinquent tax return(s) and/or tax(es) owing under IFTA and/or other tax statutes administered by the Taxation Division.

<u>Manitoba Fuel Tax Rates – 4th Quarter 2018</u>

As announced on October 4, 2018, Manitoba is not implementing a carbon tax. Therefore, the fuel tax rates for clear gasoline and clear diesel will remain at 14.0¢ per litre for the 4th quarter 2018.

File and Pay Online with TAXcess – manitoba.ca/TAXcess

Effective **October 1, 2018**, you will be able to file your IFTA Quarterly Tax Returns on TAXcess. This exciting development will allow you to input your kilometres traveled and fuel purchased and TAXcess will calculate the tax due or tax credit. You will no longer be required to file a paper return. You can also pay any tax due after filing.

If you pay only through TAXcess, please remember to send a copy of the return and worksheet to our office via email, fax or mail (see our contact information below). Returns that are not received will be considered late filed and penalty and interest will be assessed.

Filing IFTA Returns During a Potential Postal Disruption

While the impact of a potential postal disruption on mail delivery is unknown at this time, please be advised that the due date for the IFTA tax returns does not change because of a disruption.

To ensure that your IFTA return and payments are received on time, you can:

- File and Pay your tax return online using our TAXcess service at <u>manitoba.ca/TAXcess</u>.
 Note that if payment is only made online through TAXcess, you must still file your return and it must be received by the Taxation Division by the due date.
- E-mail your return to MBTax@gov.mb.ca
- **Fax** your return to 204-948-2087
- **Deliver** your return and payment to either of the Taxation Division office locations listed at the bottom of this page.

Third Quarter Due Date: Wednesday October 31st, 2018

To avoid penalties and interest, returns must be filed and any amount due must be paid by the above date.

IFTA Credentials Processing

Our goal is to respond to your IFTA credentials requests in a timely manner. Once the completed application form with payment (if applicable) is received and approved, we will process your request and forward to you as required by mail, fax or e-mail within the following response times:

Renewal of IFTA credentials – ten (10) business days; during peak periods credentials will be mailed by December 31st if received by December 15th.

Initial IFTA Registration – seven (7) to ten (10) business days.

Additional Decals – one (1) business day

Temporary Decal Permit – one (1) business day, for urgent requests contact us at 204-945-5457

In person requests at our Winnipeg and Brandon offices during business hours will be completed within one (1) hour.

Response times may vary if all tax accounts are not in good standing.

Electronic Image of IFTA Licence

Beginning **January 1, 2019**, you will be allowed to carry your IFTA licence in an electronic image or a paper copy.

Further details will be available with your 2019 IFTA Renewal.

Display of 2019 Renewal Credentials

You may operate with the 2019 IFTA decals and licence beginning November 1, 2018. However, please note that you are responsible for filing the fourth quarter 2018 return. Failure to do so may result in suspension of your IFTA credentials.

IFTA Decals—Important Information

The proper placement of IFTA decals will help you avoid costly delays on the road. See information below:

- Manitoba Taxation and the IFTA Law Enforcement Committee require that valid IFTA decals are affixed on the exterior portion of both sides of the cab.

- Do not place IFTA decals on windows, mirrors, tanks or vents.
- Do not use a pressure washer directly on the decals.
- Please remove all expired or non-valid decals from your vehicle.
