We will be discussing this with COPR as they do the initial evaluation of international applicants and they have a six-month requirement for English Language proficiency testing. This will include regulators from other provinces, and where needed ask the other provincial regulators to consult with their Provincial Fair Registration Practices Office. We will attempt to have change instituted at COPR, but cannot give a timeline.</p>	TBD	Completed
	<p>2. As discussed, once equivalency is established by COPR, the international candidate is required to write the COPR entry to practice exam at the level their equivalency was established at. Should they successfully complete the English COPR exam, CPMB deems them to be proficient in English.</p>	Existing	In place
