## **STANDARDS**

## 531.1 Preplacement service goals

Preplacement services are provided to help the child according to his/her age and capacity, to prevent identity problems or resolve them if they exist, and to enhance feelings of self-worth.

Preplacement services include determining the capacity and readiness of the child to accept a new parent.

## 531.2 Results

Preplacement services help the child with problems of anxiety of separation from his/her birth family and/or other caregivers and obtain for him/her the sanctions of the birth family or other caregivers to belong to another family and learn to love new parents.

## 531.3 Professional knowledge required

Workers assigned to prepare a child for adoption are familiar with separation and attachment, and child development theories.
